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

# Principle of use

 For voltage measurements, a current proportional to the measured voltage must be collected through an external resistor R<sub>p</sub> which is selected by the user and installed in series with the primary circuit of the transducer.

This transducer must be used in electric/electronic equipment with respect to applicable standards and safety requirements in accordance with the manufacturer's operating instructions.




Caution, risk of electrical shock

When operating the transducer, certain parts of the module can carry hazardous voltage (e.g. primary busbar, power supply). Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.

This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation. A protective housing or additional shield could be used. Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

### **Mechanical characteristics**

General tolerance ±0.3 mm
 Transducer fastening 2 holes Ø 6.5 mm
 2 M6 steel screws
 Recommended fastening torque 5 N⋅m

Connection of primary M5 screw terminals
Recommended fastening torque 2.2 N·m

Connection of secondary Faston 6.3 × 0.8 mm

### **Remarks**

- $I_{\rm S}$  is positive when  $V_{\rm P}$  is applied on terminal +HT.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100 °C.
- Installation of the transducer must be done unless otherwise specified on the datasheet, according to LEM Transducer Generic Mounting Rules. Please refer to LEM document N°ANE120504 available on our Web site: Products/Product Documentation.

#### Instructions for use of the voltage transducer model LV 100/SP47

Primary resistor  $R_p$ : the transducer's optimum accuracy is obtained at the nominal primary current. As far as possible,  $R_p$  should be calculated so that the nominal voltage to be measured corresponds to a primary current of 10 mA.

Example: Voltage to be measured  $V_{\rm P\,N}$  = 1000 V

a)  $R_{\rm p} = 100 \; {\rm k}\Omega \, / \, 40 \; {\rm W}, \, I_{\rm p} = 10 \; {\rm mA}$  Accuracy = ±0.7 % of  $V_{\rm p\,N}$  (@  $T_{\rm A}$  = +25 °C) b)  $R_{\rm p} = 400 \; {\rm k}\Omega / \, \, 5 \; {\rm W}, \, I_{\rm p} = 2.5 \; {\rm mA}$  Accuracy = ±2.5 % of  $V_{\rm p\,N}$  (@  $T_{\rm A}$  = +25 °C)

Operating range (recommended): taking into account the resistance of the primary windings (which must remain low compared to  $R_p$  in order to keep thermal deviation as low as possible) and the insulation, this transducer is suitable for measuring nominal voltages from 100 to 2500 V.
