When operating the transducer, certain parts of the module can carry hazardous voltage (eg. primary busbar, power supply).


Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.

This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

A protective housing or additional shield could be used. Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

Mechanical characteristics

• General tolerance

- ± 1 mm
- Transducer fastening
- 4 slots Ø 5.5 mm 4 M5 steel screws
- Recommended fastening torque 2.2 N·m
- Primary through-hole
- Connection of secondary
- 27.5 x 8 mm Burndy SMS6GE6

Remarks

- $I_{\rm s}$ is positive when $I_{\rm p}$ flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100 °C.
- Dynamic performances (d*i*/d*t* and response time) are best with a single bar completely filling the primary hole.
